



Community Foundation Awards Criteria

AWARD FOR EXCELLENCE AND ACHIEVEMENT

Where possible demonstrate that the nominee:

- has made a major contribution to a specific community foundation or community foundations in general;
- has had at least five years involvement in the community foundation movement;
- has given freely of their time and knowledge and provided mentoring to others within the community foundation movement;
- has impacted on their community and/or is a public advocate for community philanthropy;
- is seen as a leader, a 'go to' person by others;
- has a commitment to community foundation's and actively growing their foundation(s);
- has proven able to overcome barriers; and
- shows initiative and is a visionary for their community foundation and/or the community foundation movement.

NEW ACHIEVERS AWARD

Nominees must have been involved in the community foundation movement for less than two years and must have made at least one significant achievement to improve their community foundation and its presence in the community.

Where possible demonstrate that the nominee:

- is an advocate for the community foundation movement;
- has increased the financial income of the community foundation;
- has shown an ability to work well with their community and peer community foundation's;
- has demonstrated excellent examples of initiative, planning and execution in fundraising, grantmaking and/or community development;
- goes that extra mile.

Your nomination should include name and details of the nominee and include your written submission (not more than two A4 pages) addressing the criteria and signed off by two of your Foundation's directors. Supporting documentation including photographs and media is invited.
